

NEW STATE AGENCY FOR REGISTRATION, VALUATION, SURVEYING

The new state agency Tailte Éireann, brought about by the merger of the Property Registration Authority, the Valuation Office and Ordnance Survey Ireland, will provide a comprehensive and secure property title registration system, a professional State valuation service and an authoritative national mapping and surveying infrastructure.

All functions previously carried out by the Property Registration Authority, the Commissioner of Valuation, the Boundary Surveyor and Ordnance Survey Ireland will now be performed by Tailte Éireann.

The new state agency provides a comprehensive and secure property title registration system, a professional state valuation service and an authoritative national mapping and surveying infrastructure. As an integrated land and property service, the state agency will help to support the planning process and professionals; one central body for information and data to assist planning and land information.

The Minister of State with responsibility for Local Government and Planning, Kieran O'Donnell, said that as the primary national source of property information and geospatial data, Tailte Éireann will be a leader in developing and delivering land information services.

On officially launching the new state agency Tailte Éireann at the Distillers Building, Minister O'Donnell added: "These functions are essential for underpinning the state's economy in many areas, including property, planning, agriculture, local government, the environment, and construction."

Liz Pope, Acting Chief Executive of Tailte Éireann, expressed her gratitude to colleagues from the three merged organisations for their ongoing work and commitment, especially throughout the merger process.

She also thanked colleagues from the Department of Housing, Local Government, and Heritage for their assistance in establishing Tailte Éireann. "We look forward to working collaboratively with all our stakeholders in developing integrated land and property services in Ireland," Pope added.

Headed by a Chief Executive, Tailte Éireann has a statutory
